





**Explanatory Notes**

This is Namibia Senior Secondary Certificate (NSSC) Ordinary Level statement of results. The Directorate of National Examinations and Assessment reserves the right to amend the information on this statement. Results will be confirmed by the issue of a certificate.

NSSC Ordinary Level results are reported on a 8-point scale of grades: A\*(a\*), A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), F(f) or G(g), grade A\*(a\*) being the highest and grade G(g) the lowest.

U(u) means **UNGRADED** indicating the standard achieved is below the standard required for grade G(g).

X(x) means the candidate has **NO RESULT** in the respective subject, indicating that a result cannot be issued because of absence for the whole or part of the examination in the subject or because of a decision not to issue a result for some other reason.

Q(q) means the candidate has a **PENDING** result in the respective subject, indicating a result cannot be issued at present but will follow in due course.

The NSSC Ordinary Level Office Practice includes the assessment of typing speed which is reported separately as a words per minute endorsement. The words per minute will be recorded on certificates provided the overall syllabus result is grade G(g) or higher.

Only subjects in which NSSC Ordinary Level grade A\*(a) to G(g) are achieved will be recorded on certificates.
